Dear Chair Senator Prozanski, Vice-Chair Senator Thatcher, and Members of the Senate Committee On Judiciary and Ballot Measure 110 Implementation,

My name is Mason Drummond and I'm a High School junior in Portland, Oregon. I am testifying today in support of SB 554, to keep guns out of schools and ensure that we can make safe choices for our communities.

As a student, I don't feel safe knowing that myself or my friends could be around guns when we're in public spaces or at schools.
