I write this letter in Opposition of Senate Bill 554. Concealed carry holders are some of the most outstanding citizens we have in this Country. Concealed carry holders help prevent and stop crimes every day. Before anyone can receive a concealed handgun license in Oregon they must first, pass an approved firearms training course, undergo an in depth background check and pay a fee. If approved they are then able to legally carry a concealed handgun. Carrying a concealed firearm allows a person to legally protect themselves without bystanders who currently are uncomfortable and unfamiliar with firearms from feeling intimidated or wary based on lack of understanding.
