Chair Prozanski and Vice Chair Thatcher:

RE: SB 554

The Founders of our Nation drafted the First Amendment of our great Constitution guaranteeing rights, freedoms and parameters as to rights of free speech, freedom of religion, freedom of assembly, freedom of the press, and to petition their governments. These inalienable rights are guaranteed.

The Second Amendment was drafted so as to allow citizens to protect the First Amendment rights, their homes, their families and communities by guaranteeing "the right of the people to keep and bear arms" and that this shall NOT be infringed upon.
