My name is Walter Kennedy, and I am submitting this written testimony in opposition to Senate Bill 554 and its amendments.

SB 554 does nothing to make Oregon any safer, in fact it does just the opposite. At a time when violence and destruction has been raging in the streets for nearly a year this bill hand cuffs the state's most law-abiding citizens. This bill only creates felony traps by allowing nearly any public agency to create their own rules regarding CHL holders.
