Although I have never had to use my firearm in defense of my person and I hope I never have to. I feel much safer with my handgun at my side. I have great respect for the women and men in law enforcement and with the current state of Oregon and the US their job is not easy. The majority of personal attacks do not take place while law enforcement is at the location. These incidents happen in minutes.
