The Oregon Bioscience Association (OR Bio) and the Biotechnology Innovation Organization (BIO) respectfully oppose HB 2044, which would make a number of changes to existing Prescription Drug Price Transparency program.

Our organizations have repeatedly expressed on our members' behalf an interest in working with the Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS) on good faith compliance with the Prescription Drug Price Transparency program. Yet instead of working collaboratively to resolve problems with existing law, DCBS has put forth HB 2044 to establish new and questionable requirements.
