Drug Price Transparency - Program overview The program is directed by statute to receive: New drug reports for high cost drugs Annual price increase reports 60-day advance notice of a price increase



Insurers reports on top 25 lists



Consumers reports on price increases

HB 2044 – Technical fixes for the Drug Price Transparency Program

The bill provides changes to improve the implementation of the program through:

- Enabling efficient access to the All Payer, All Claims database
- Protecting sensitive and personally identifiable consumer information reported to the program

HB 2044 – Technical fixes for the Drug Price Transparency Program

The bill provides changes to improve the implementation of the program through:

- Requiring new drug reports to include information on patient assistance programs
- Expanding health insurer reporting by requiring reports from other insurance markets
