I am a resident of Alaska, which is warming twice as fast as the global average and already feeling the effects of climate change: seafood die offs, ice melt, wildfires.

Alaska is home to several important feedback loops in the climate system, such as melting Arctic sea ice and melting permafrost,

that threaten to escalate out of control resulting in severe societal disruption. The most cost effective and efficient solution to reduce carbon emissions at the speed and scale necessary is to put a price on carbon and refund the revenue back as a dividend. This "carbon dividend" policy has been endorsed by more economists than any other policy in history, on any topic.
