Dear Chair Prozanski and members of the Senate Committee On Judiciary and Ballot Measure 110 Implementation,

I am writing in support of SB 775 and to urge you to do everything you can to ensure the full implementation of the Drug Addiction Treatment & Recovery Act as quickly as possible. Oregon is in an overdose crisis and has failed to invest in the kind of coordinated, well-resourced treatment system that would help people recover and live long, healthy lives.
