This is a HUGE need in Oregon, as there are so many motorcycle riders and so few car drivers that seem to notice or understand the relationship between cars and bikes. I have seen and been a part of many accidents that likely could have been avoided had there been more lane sharing rules in place. There are also many studies proving that the lack of motorcycle rights causes a high accident toll. Also, being exposed to the elements such as hot weather and having to stay idol on hot tarmac is very dangerous on a motorcycle when you're covered in heavy leather.
