

Dear Chair and Members of the House Committee on Education,

My name is Nicole Seawright and I am a parent of 2 children residing in Clackamas County. I am writing in support HB 2631 which prescribes notification requirements for school districts upon receipt of an act of harassment, bullying or cyberbullying.

HB 2631 is important to me because:

- Without this law, school districts are **not required** to notify parents of students who are victims and aggressors in incidents of harassment and bullying.
- Research shows that peer harassment leads to depression, decreased self-worth, hopelessness and loneliness which contribute to suicidal thoughts and actions.
- If parents are not informed about their child's involvement in bullying at school as either the victim or aggressor, they will not be able to provide needed mental health support.
