

Dear Judiciary Committee members,

I am writing to voice my objection to HB 2543. This bill by its own explanation is to delay the purchase of a firearm without cause or due process. If the Legislature enacts laws by regulating the purchase of firearms connected to background checks, then the Legislature is obligated to provide a clear and concise process for the completing and processing of those requirements. No citizen should be denied the right to purchase a firearm SIMPLY because, some one or group, doesn't think it has time or the willingness or funding to complete the task. If HB2543 is enacted it's clear that the Legislature is in bad faith and is in fact infringing on a Person's right to legally acquire a firearm in a limited time. There is no reason for the legislation the present system is working properly! the legislature is directly at fault for any issues of manpower and funding to complete the background checks in a timely manner!
