HB 3073 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

(1:00 PM) Changes name of Early Learning Division to Early Learning Authority.

HB 2503 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

(1:05 PM) Expands eligibility for certain child care subsidy programs.

HB 2484 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Housing

(1:10 PM) Requires landlord to allow dwelling to be used as family child care home.

HB 2662 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

(1:15 PM) Appropriates moneys to Department of Education for transfer to Coquille School District for Lincoln School of Early Learning.

HB 2670 ** *Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
