WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Provides that when state agency is required by statute to mail notice to person, and agency has on file post office box address for person, agency must mail notice to post office box address.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-2 Replaces the measure.

If a state agency has a P.O. Box on file for a person as the last known address on file and the P.O. Box is the address to which the person has requested mailed notices be sent, directs state agencies to mail the notice to the P.O. Box. States that this mailing fulfills service by mail requirements and that if an agency fails to comply, but the person still receives notice, the notice is not invalidated.

FISCAL: Has minimal fiscal impact
