**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Requires Criminal Justice Commission to study issues relating to requiring all law enforcement agencies in the state to use body-worn cameras. Requires results of study be reported to appropriate interim committee of the Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2021.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

Oregon law requires law enforcement agencies that utilize body worn cameras to have policies and procedure in place for the use, storage, and retention of the video and audio recordings that record an officer's interaction with members of the public while the officer is on duty.

Senate Bill 668 requires the Criminal Justice Commission to study issues relating to requiring all law enforcement agencies in the state to use body-worn cameras and to report back to the appropriate legislative committee no later than December 31, 2021.
