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Measure Description:

Requires Department of Human Services to administer program to provide matching grants to cities or counties to operate mobile crisis intervention teams.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Department of Human Services (DHS), Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST), Counties, Cities

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Health Care to the House Committee on Behavioral Health.

The measure directs the Department of Human Services (DHS) to administer a program that provides 50 percent matching grants to cities or counties for mobile crisis intervention team programs. The measure appropriates \$10 million General Fund to DHS to provide grants and fund one full-time position for the City of Eugene to provide support to the city’s mobile crisis intervention team.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Oregon Health Authority, Department of Public Safety Standards and Training, Counties, Cities and DHS.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Behavioral Health.
