**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2046**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after “442.373,” insert
2 “743.025.”

3 On page 14, after line 11, insert:

4 **“SECTION 13.** ORS 743.025 is amended to read:

5 “743.025. (1) An insurer shall [*include with any filing under ORS*
6 *743.018*] **annually report to the Department of Consumer and Business**
7 **Services, in the manner and format prescribed by the department,** the
8 following information regarding drugs reimbursed by the insurer under [*pol-*
9 *icies or certificates*] **health benefit plans, as defined in ORS 743B.005,** is-
10 sued **by the insurer** in this state:

11 “(a) The 25 most frequently prescribed drugs;

12 “(b) The 25 most costly drugs as a portion of total annual spending;

13 “(c) The 25 drugs that have caused the greatest increase in total plan
14 spending from one year to the next; and

15 “(d) The impact of the costs of prescription drugs on premium rates.

16 “(2) The department [*of Consumer and Business Services*] shall conduct a
17 public hearing annually on prescription drug prices, information reported to
18 the department under ORS 646A.689 and information described in subsection
19 (1) of this section.

20 “(3) The department shall regularly update the interim committees of the
21 Legislative Assembly related to health on the information described in sub-

1 section (1) of this section.

2 “(4) Subsection (1) of this section applies to an insurer that issues policies
3 or certificates of health insurance for sale in this state that include a pre-
4 scription drug benefit.”.

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
