[HB 2949] states in the, "Text: [Page 2 at (26-29) an appropriation of \$3,000,000 from the General Fund], [Page 2 at (34-37) an appropriation of \$10,000,000 from the General Fund], [Page 3 at (1-4) an appropriation of \$5,000,000 from the General Fund], and the Granddaddy of them all; [Page 3 at (21-24) an appropriation of \$50,000,000 from the General Fund]" for an alleged total of:

\$68,000,000.

Amendment (-5) illustrates an intentional act of incorporation of systemic racism into Oregon law, appears in the, "Text: [Page 1 at (18-21)] and [Page 2 at (1-10)]."

Amendment (-7) states and amount of \$5,000,000 from the General Fund and dispersals in the, "Text: [Page 1 at (18-21)] and [Page 2 at (1-3)].

Amendment (-8) illustrates another intentional act of incorporation of systemic racism into Oregon law, appears in the, "Text: [Page 1 at (14-15)]."
