HB 4013

(1:10 pm) Directs Department of Education to establish pilot program in which certain school districts make one-time distributions to families of students to assist with unpaid rent, past-due utilities, or move-in expenses.

### HB 4111

(1:30 pm) Directs U of O to conduct study on prevalence of child abuse in the state and submit a report to interim cmtes. Appropriates money to HECC for study.

### HB 4122

(1:50 pm) DHS to establish program to award grants to DACA recipients for legal costs and DACA renewal apps.

### HB 4150

(2:10 pm) Requires Health Information Technology Oversight Council to convene one or more groups of stakeholders and experts to explore options to accelerate, support and improve secure, statewide community information exchanges.

### Register to testify live remotely:
