Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 1524

Modifies provisions of tax laws.

SB 1525

Updates connection date to federal Internal Revenue Code and other provisions of federal tax law.

SB 1569

Directs Department of Revenue to develop schedule allowing personal income taxpayers to voluntarily report taxpayers' self-identified race and ethnicity identifiers.

Public Hearing

SB 1506

Increases maximum percentage of tax or fee that governing body of city or county may impose on sale of marijuana items.

SB 1507

Exempts receipts from sales of prescription drugs, feminine hygiene products, diapers and baby formula from commercial activity subject to corporate activity tax.

February 7, 2022

SB 1559

Provides that personal property tax returns not required for floating homes unless new property or new improvements have been added to property tax account since preceding assessment year.

SJR 203

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to remove requirement that bonded indebtedness incurred under Article XI-G be matched by amount at least equal to amount of indebtedness.
