Public Hearing

HB 4021

Extends period in which taxpayers, upon transfer of ownership of homestead or moving manufactured structure or floating home out of state, may discontinue participation in homestead property tax deferral program in assessment year.

HB 4056

Requires annual adjustment for inflation of amount to be retained, for distribution to cities, counties and other entities from Oregon Marijuana Account, prior to transfer of remainder of account balance to Drug Treatment and Recovery Services Fund.

SJR 203

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to remove requirement that bonded indebtedness incurred under Article XI-G be matched by amount at least equal to amount of indebtedness.

Work Session

SB 1506

Increases maximum percentage of tax or fee that governing body of city or county may impose on sale of marijuana items.

SB 1524

Modifies provisions of tax laws.
