#### Work Session

SB 1502

Creates income or corporate excise tax credit allowed to small forestland owner that elects to observe riparian timber harvest restriction applicable to large forestland owner, in lieu of using harvest option available to small forestland owner.

SB 1519 A

Grants property tax exemption for proportion of community solar project that is owned by residential customers or leased by residential subscribers.

HB 4021

Extends period in which taxpayers, upon transfer of ownership of homestead or moving manufactured structure or floating home out of state, may discontinue participation in homestead property tax deferral program in assessment year.

Requires annual adjustment for inflation of amount to be retained, for distribution to cities, counties and other entities from Oregon Marijuana Account, prior to transfer of remainder of account balance to Drug Treatment and Recovery Services Fund.
