SB 1587

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-10-2022 MEETING: Subjects building or premises used for unlawful growing or handling of industrial hemp to lien and allows building or premises to be sold to pay all fines and costs.

SB 1560

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-10-2022 MEETING: Updates statutory references to individual who is not citizen or national of United States to replace "alien" with "noncitizen."

Directs state agencies to use "noncitizen" in rules and regulations to reference individual who is not citizen or national of United States and to update rules and regulations that use "alien" to use "noncitizen."

Makes nonsubstantive changes.

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-10-2022 MEETING: Establishes Medical Release Advisory Committee within State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision.

SB 1511 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-10-2022 MEETING: Creates process by which person convicted or found guilty except for insanity as result of nonunanimous jury verdict may file petition for post-conviction relief within one year of effective date of Act.
