SUMMARY

Transfers Oregon Pre-Disaster Mitigation Fund to Oregon Department of Emergency Management.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

- 2 Relating to state financial administration; creating new provisions; amending
- 3 ORS 401.532; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 401.532 is amended to read:
- 6 401.532. (1) The Oregon Pre-Disaster Mitigation Fund is established in the
- 7 State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund. Moneys re-
- 8 ceived from federal grants for pre-disaster mitigation efforts shall be depos-
- 9 ited into the Oregon Pre-Disaster Mitigation Fund. Moneys in the fund are
- 10 continuously appropriated to the [Oregon Military Department] Oregon De-
- 11 partment of Emergency Management to be used to:
- 12 (a) Help state agencies and local government units with Federal Emer-
- 13 gency Management Agency approved mitigation plans in this state prior to
- 14 the occurrence of natural disasters; and
- 15 (b) Ensure, to the extent possible, that state and local agencies and offi-
- 16 cials are prepared to respond to threats of human-caused disaster, including
- 17 but not limited to acts of terrorism.
- 18 (2) The Oregon Pre-Disaster Mitigation Fund may receive gifts, grants,
- 19 bequests, endowments and donations from public and private sources for
- 20 purposes related to the fund.

1	(3) The [Oregon Military Department] Oregon Department of Emer-
2	gency Management shall adopt rules for the disbursement of moneys from
3	the Oregon Pre-Disaster Mitigation Fund.
4	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 401.532 by section 1 of this
5	2022 Act become operative on July 1, 2022.
6	SECTION 3. This 2022 Act being necessary for the immediate pres-
7	ervation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is de-
8	clared to exist, and this 2022 Act takes effect on its passage.
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
