



Pesticide Regulation



ORS Chapter 634

Foundational statute for Oregon's pesticide program that governs ODA's enforcement and education authorities

EPA & ODA Cooperative Agreement

Legal agreement that outlines the delegate authorities from EPA to ODA

EPA & FIFRA

Foundational federal law and authority that governs all pesticide use, manufacturing, and sales in all 50 states



State and Federal Responsibilities



Oregon Department of Agriculture

- Register pesticides for sale in Oregon
- Investigate and enforce pesticide requirements
- License applicators
- Establish and implement certification and training programs
- Collaborate with state and federal partners for pesticide stewardship
- Regulate pesticides within authorities
- Provide for special local needs & emergency situations



Environmental Protection Agency

- Register pesticides for use in U.S.
- Evaluate new pesticides & uses
- Review safety of all pesticides
- Register pesticide producing establishments
- Develop & enforce pesticide requirements



HB 4062 (2022)



- Provides ODA authority to establish new license types by rule
 - Existing licenses in statute
 - New licenses within exiting authorities
 - A -1 is being drafted
- HB 4062 Implementation
 - Provide better education and training
 - Private/Commercial hybrid
 - Forward looking capacity
