#### **Measure Description:**

Authorizes public employers to require a veteran to provide evidence of eligibility for veterans preference at the time of application. Requires public employers to provide a written explanation if the employer decides not to interview the veteran. Removes the Veteran Educational Bridge Grant Program sunset. Designates a portion of Highway 30 as an Oregon Veterans Memorial Highway and specifies provisions for signage.
