Subject: HB 4075- Relating to restitution

Work Session Recommendations

This measure modifies the procedures for district attorneys to request and courts to order restitution in criminal cases and defines certain awards of restitution as Level 1 priority of payment in criminal judgements in circuit courts and local courts and restitution as a Level II obligation. The measure takes effect on January 1, 2023.

The measure has a minimal fiscal impact and a Revenue Impact Statement has been issued. Both of which are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System.
