SB 1550 – Relating to the Office of Immigrant and Refugee Subject:

Advancement

Work Session Recommendations

SB 1550 transfers the Office of Immigrant and Refugee Advancement from the Office of the Governor to the Department of Human Services (DHS) including all employees, records, property, and unexpended revenues.

Specifically, SB 1550 would authorize the transfer of four positions (3.83 FTE) and \$1,376,037 General Fund from the Office of the Governor to DHS. These budget adjustments will be included in HB 5202, the 2022 legislative session Omnibus Budget measure.

The measure previously had hearings in the Senate Committee on Human Services, Mental Health and Recovery on 2/8/2022 and 2/10/2022 and was reported out with a do pass.
