**Subject:** HB 4124 – Relating to the collection of student data  
Work Session Recommendations

HB 4124 A requires the Oregon Department of Education to survey academic assessments administered by school districts, establish best practices related to district-level assessments, and make recommendations regarding the use of assessments. The measure requires the timely transfer of complete educational records in certain circumstances, as well as a report to the Legislature and to the State Board of Education by May 1, 2024 on the required elements of the survey.

### **Recommended Changes**

LFO recommends adoption of the -A2 amendment, which appropriates \$193,482 General Fund to the Department of Education to conduct the survey and provide the required report.

### **Final Subcommittee Action**

LFO recommends that HB 4124, as amended by the -A2 amendment, to be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
