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Measure Description:

Increases the maximum percentage of a tax or fee that the governing body of a city may impose on the sale of marijuana items, if the city is located in a county that borders a state where it is illegal to sell marijuana items and the county has a population of at least 30,000 residents in the most recent federal decennial census. Applies to marijuana items produced, processed, or sold on or after January 1, 2023.

Cities, Department of Revenue (DOR)

Analysis:
