**Subject:** HB 4072 – Relating to authorizations issued by the State Fish and Wildlife Commission  
Work Session Recommendations

HB 4072 eliminates the Department of Fish and Wildlife's one-day angling license and decreases the rates for a one-day angling and shellfish license from \$32.50 to \$23.00. Currently a one-day angling license is \$23. This reduction is anticipated to reduce the Department's biennial revenues by around \$500,000.

Additionally, the measure establishes the Rogue-South Coast Steelhead Validation and Rogue-South Coast Wild Steelhead Harvest Cards with revenue for those fees deposited into the Rogue-South Coast Research and Monitoring Subaccount. This fee is designed to provide dedicated funding for new research and monitoring actions associated with implementing the Rogue-South Coast Multi-species Conservation and Management Plan.

### **Recommended Changes**

LFO recommends adoption of the -A4 amendment, which was provided by Legislative Counsel to correct a drafting error.

### **Final Subcommittee Action**

LFO recommends that HB 4072, as amended by the -A4 amendment, to be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
