Measure Description:

Directs University of Oregon to conduct study on prevalence of child abuse in this state and to submit report regarding study to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to human services.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Analysis: This measure directs the University of Oregon (UO) to conduct a study on the prevalence of child abuse in this state and to submit a report with the results of the study to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to Human Services no later than September 15, 2023. The measure also appropriates \$700,000 General Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for the purposes of the measure.

UO estimates the expenses will include \$546,916 for salaries and related expenses for one faculty member and two research assistants and \$153,084 for services and supplies.

The Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO) also notes that appropriations are generally not made directly to public universities such as the University of Oregon but to HECC for distribution to a public university.
