Measure Description:

Corrects statutory reference from "return identification envelope" to "secrecy envelope." Directs the Secretary of State to ensure that for recounts for the office of President and Vice President of the United States, United States Senate, United States House of Representatives, Governor, Secretary of State, State Treasurer, Attorney General, Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries, Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, Oregon Tax Court, Circuit Court, Oregon Senate, Oregon House of Representatives and statewide measures, county elections officials conduct the recount in a manner that is consistent, transparent, accurate and in accordance with all applicable laws.
