**Analysis:** The measure clarifies statutes for failure to use traction tires or chains and changes the distribution of privilege tax revenues.

The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), the Department of Environmental Quality, and the Department of Revenue do not anticipate a fiscal impact due to the provisions of this bill. The changes in the distribution of privilege tax revenues will likely decrease revenues to ODOT and the Connect Oregon and multimodal programs.
