Measure Description:

Transfers Oregon Pre-Disaster Mitigation Fund to Oregon Department of Emergency Management.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Department of Emergency Management, Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Department of Forestry (ODF), Oregon Business Development Department (OBDD), Oregon Military Department (OMD)

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

Costs related to the measure may require budgetary action - See analysis.

Analysis:

HB 4156 - A implements statutory changes necessary to support the 2021-23 legislatively adopted budget and to clarify the application of statutes. This measure, relating to state financial administration, is not an appropriation bill and therefore does not include the appropriation of funds. The measure has an emergency clause and is effective on passage.

The following table summarizes, by section and agency, the fiscal impact of this measure; however, for those sections with a budgetary impact, the associated budget measure is noted. The fiscal or budgetary impacts of provisions of this measure are contained in HB 5202 (omnibus budget bill) for the 2021-23 biennium.
