WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

This measure prohibits the acceptance of wagers or providing gambling services in connection with greyhound racing, regardless of the state or country in which the race takes place. A person who commits such crime could receive punishments of maximum five years' imprisonment, a \$125,000 fine, or both, a Class C felony. This measure also prohibits wagering on greyhound racing, regardless of the state or country in which the race takes place. A person who commits such crime could receive punishments of maximum 364 days' imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both, a Class A misdemeanor.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

The Oregon Racing Commission estimated a revenue loss of \$7 million from the six of the nine Advance Deposit Wagering (ADW) companies leaving the state due to the restrictions proposed in the introduced bill.
