26 "<u>SECTION 13.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on 27 expenditures established by section 3, chapter 379, Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium end-28 ing June 30, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other 29 revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, 30 collected or received by the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, is increased by \$130,978.

SECTION 14. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 1 (1), chapter 640, Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission for administrative expenses, is in-

1 creased by \$155,127.".
