

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4074

7 On page 4, line 2, delete “10” and insert “8”.

8 In line 15, delete “11” and insert “9”.

9 In line 28, delete “12” and insert “10”.

10 Delete lines 29 through 32 and insert:

11 **“SECTION 11. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**  
12 **priated to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023,**  
13 **out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,000,000, for deposit into the Illegal Marijuana**  
14 **Market Enforcement Grant Program Fund established under section 15, chapter 103, Oregon**  
15 **Laws 2018, for the purpose of responding to humanitarian crises associated with unlawful**  
16 **marijuana cultivation and distribution operations.**

17 **“SECTION 12. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**  
18 **expenditures established by section 3, chapter 379, Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium end-**  
19 **ing June 30, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other**  
20 **revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds,**  
21 **collected or received by the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, is increased by \$6,000,000,**  
22 **for additional grants under the Illegal Marijuana Market Enforcement Grant Program es-**  
23 **tablished under section 13, chapter 103, Oregon Laws 2018, for financial assistance to**  
24 **community-based organizations that are responding to the humanitarian crises associated**  
25 **with unlawful marijuana cultivation and distribution operations.**

26 **“SECTION 13. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**  
27 **expenditures established by section 3, chapter 379, Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium end-**  
28 **ing June 30, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other**  
29 **revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds,**  
30 **collected or received by the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, is increased by \$130,978.**

31 **“SECTION 14. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**  
32 **expenditures established by section 1 (1), chapter 640, Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium**  
33 **ending June 30, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of fees, moneys or other revenues,**  
34 **including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds collected or**  
35 **received by the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission for administrative expenses, is in-**

1 **creased by \$155,127.”.**

4 In line 39, delete “5 to 7” and insert “3 to 5”.
