

House Bill 4107

Sponsored by Representative SMITH WARNER; Representative ALONSO LEON (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Legislative Policy and Research Director to study use of impact statements in legislative deliberations and to report findings to Legislative Policy and Research Committee on or before February 1, 2023.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to impact statements; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Legislative Policy and Research Director shall study the use of impact**
5 **statements in legislative deliberations and shall report findings to the Legislative Policy and**
6 **Research Committee on or before February 1, 2023.**

7 **SECTION 2. This 2022 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2022**
8 **regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
