CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the State Department of Agriculture and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

- (1) Industrial hemp grower
criminal record check..... \$ 75
- (2) Commercial feed
registration \$ 40
- (3) Commercial feeds
nonmanufacturing license..... \$ 150
- (4) Commercial feeds
manufacturing license
by tonnage distributed:
 - (a) Less than 5,000 tons \$ 150
 - (b) 5,000 to 9,999 tons \$ 300
 - (c) 10,000 to 19,999 tons \$ 450
 - (d) 20,000 to 30,000 tons \$ 600
 - (e) Greater than 30,000 tons \$ 750

SECTION 2. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the Oregon Health Authority and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

- (1) Genetic Counseling Program:

SECTION 3. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), a fingerprinting fee of \$58, adopted by the Oregon State Board of Nursing and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, is approved.

SECTION 4. This 2022 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2022 Act takes effect on its passage.
