16 Oregon Department of Administrative Services, is approved.

17       “**SECTION 4.** This 2022 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
18 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2022 Act takes effect  
19 on its passage.”.
