SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs State Forestry Department to study Oregon forests. Requires department to report to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to forests no later than December 31, 2023. Sunsets January 2, 2024.

A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to forests. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. The State Forestry Department shall study Oregon forests. The department shall report its findings and recommendations to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to forests no later than December 31, 2023. SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2022 Act is repealed on January 2, 2024.
