13	"(b) 'Institution of higher education' has the meaning given that
14	term in ORS 350.300.
15	"(2) Notwithstanding ORS 341.290, 352.105 or 353.050, a person who
16	is enrolled in courses totaling one or more credit hours at an institu-
17	tion of higher education as an undergraduate student is eligible to
18	have the amount of tuition and all fees levied against the person

"(b) Has completed and submitted the Free Application for Federal

"(a) Is a current or former homeless youth;

- Student Aid (FASFA) for the academic year in which the person is applying for the tuition and fee waiver;
- "(c) Is attending an institution of higher education for purposes of pursuing an initial undergraduate degree; and
- 5 "(d) Has not yet completed the equivalent of four years of under-6 graduate education.
  - "(2)(a) A person who wishes to receive the tuition and fee waiver under this section shall submit an application in accordance with rules adopted by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission.
  - "(b) The commission shall grant the first 300 applications for tuition and fee waivers under this section that the commission receives from eligible applicants in each academic year.
  - "(3) A tuition and fee waiver granted under this section may be reduced by the amount of any federal aid scholarships or grants, an award from the Oregon Opportunity Grant program established under ORS 348.205, tuition and fee waivers under ORS 350.300 and any other aid received from the institution of higher education. For the purposes of this subsection, 'federal aid scholarships or grants' does not include Chafee Educational and Training Voucher Program grants under 42 U.S.C. 677.
    - **"SECTION 3a.** ORS 350.300 is amended to read:
  - "350.300. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 341.290, 352.105 or 353.050, a current foster child or former foster child under 25 years of age who is enrolled in courses totaling one or more credit hours at an institution of higher education as an undergraduate student shall have the amount of tuition and all fees levied against the student waived if attending an institution of higher education for purposes of pursuing an initial undergraduate degree.
  - "(2) A student who is a current foster child or former foster child is entitled to waiver of tuition and all fees under subsection (1) of this section until the student has received the equivalent of four years of undergraduate

- "(3) As a condition of receiving a tuition waiver for an academic year, a current foster child or former foster child must complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FASFA) for that academic year.
- "(4) A waiver of tuition and all fees under subsection (1) of this section 5 may be reduced by the amount of any federal aid scholarships or grants, an 6 award from the Oregon Opportunity Grant program established under ORS 7 348.205, a tuition and fee waiver under section 3 of this 2022 Act and 8 any other aid received from the institution of higher education. For the 9 purposes of this subsection, 'federal aid scholarships or grants' does not in-10 clude Chafee [Education] **Educational** and Training [Grant vouchers (P.L. 11 107-133)] Voucher Program grants under 42 U.S.C. 677. 12
- "(5) As used in this section:
- "(a) 'Former foster child' means an individual who, for a total of six or more months while between 14 and 21 years of age, was:
- "(A) A ward of the court pursuant to ORS 419B.100 (1)(b) to (e), in the legal custody of the Department of Human Services for out-of-home placement and not dismissed from care before reaching 16 years of age; or
- "(B) An Indian child subject to ORS 419B.600 to 419B.654, under the jurisdiction of a tribal court for out-of-home placement and not dismissed from care before reaching 16 years of age.
- 22 "(b) 'Institution of higher education' means:
- 23 "(A) A public university listed in ORS 352.002;
- "(B) A community college operated under ORS chapter 341; or
- 25 "(C) The Oregon Health and Science University.
- "SECTION 3b. Section 3 of this 2022 Act and the amendments to ORS 350.300 by section 3a of this 2022 Act first apply to tuition and fee waivers granted for the 2022-2023 academic year."
- On page 5, delete lines 5 through 10 and insert:
- "(2) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is

- appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium ending
- June 30, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$35,000 for the purpose
- 3 of providing grants to programs that will assist homeless youth in applying
- 4 for and accessing the tuition and fee waivers described in section 3 of this
- 5 2022 Act or the independent residence facility program under ORS 418.475,

6 as amended by section 4 of this 2022 Act.".
