**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4066**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, after “341.522,” insert “366.924,”.

2 On page 13, after line 44, insert:

“MEMORIAL HIGHWAYS

6 **“SECTION 17.** ORS 366.924 is amended to read:

7 “366.924. (1) The portion of U.S. Highway 395, crossing the State of
8 Oregon, beginning at the California state line and ending at the Washington
9 state line, shall also be known as the World War I Veterans Memorial
10 Highway.

11 “(2) The portion of Interstate 5, crossing the State of Oregon, beginning
12 at the California state line and ending at the Washington state line, shall
13 also be known as the Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway, and as the
14 Purple Heart Trail.

15 “(3) The portion of Interstate 5, beginning in Albany and ending in Salem,
16 shall also be known as the Atomic Veterans and Atomic Cleanup Veterans
17 Memorial Highway.

18 “(4) The portion of U.S. Highway 101, crossing the State of Oregon, be-
19 ginning at the California state line and ending at the Washington state line,
20 shall also be known as the Persian Gulf, Afghanistan and Iraq Veterans
21 Memorial Highway.

1 “(5) The portion of U.S. Highway 26, beginning where the highway inter-
2 sects with U.S. Highway 101 and ending at the Idaho state line, shall also
3 be known as the POW/MIA Memorial Highway.

4 **“(6) The portion of U.S. Highway 30, beginning where the highway
5 intersects with U.S. Highway 101 and ending at the Idaho state line,
6 shall also be known as the Oregon Veterans Memorial Highway.**

7 “[~~(6)~~] (7) The Department of Transportation shall place and maintain
8 suitable markers along each highway described in this section to indicate the
9 designation of each highway.

10 **“(8) For new highway markers erected on U.S. Highway 30 pursuant
11 to subsection (6) of this section, the department shall seek approval
12 from the Federal Highway Administration, United States Department
13 of Defense and United States Department of Homeland Security to
14 include military service seals on the markers. After receiving ap-
15 proval, the Department of Transportation shall include on the markers
16 military service seals representing:**

17 **“(a) The Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps and Coast Guard of
18 the United States; and**

19 **“(b) The National Guard.**

20 “[~~(7)(a)~~] (9)(a) The department may accept moneys from and may enter
21 into agreements with veterans groups to create, install and maintain the
22 markers.

23 **“(b) The department may not use public funds for the installation and
24 maintenance of the markers.**

25 **“SECTION 18. The amendments to ORS 366.924 by section 17 of this
26 2022 Act apply to new highway markers erected on U.S. Highway 30
27 on or after the effective date of this 2022 Act.”.**

29 In line 9, delete “18” and insert “20”.
