PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4088

- Delete lines 4 through 20 of the printed bill and insert:
- "SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Human Services shall convene
- a work group to advise the department on a plan to implement a
- 4 Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program Restaurant Meals Pro-
- 5 gram in this state that will allow Supplemental Nutrition Assistance
- 6 Program recipients to use their electronic benefit cards at participat-
- 7 ing restaurants if they are:
- 8 "(a) Seniors;
- 9 "(b) Persons with disabilities; or
- 10 "(c) Homeless individuals.
- "(2) The work group shall consist of individuals representing the geographic and racial or ethnic diversity of this state who have:
- "(a) Expertise in food insecurity.
- 14 "(b) Personal experience receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assist-15 ance Program benefits.
- 16 "(c) Experience in the restaurant industry.
- "(d) Personal or professional experience in working with seniors, persons with disabilities and homeless individuals.
- "(3) The department shall solicit public feedback on the plan developed under subsection (1) of this section and ensure that the department receives feedback from an equity perspective.

- "(4) No later than September 1, 2022, the department shall report 1 to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to hu-2 man services, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, the department's 3 implementation plan for a Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program 4 Restaurant Meals Program. The implementation plan must include, 5 but is not limited to, recommendations for an evaluation of the pro-6 gram to examine: 7 "(a) Access to the program; 8 "(b) The efficacy of the program in allowing participants to obtain 9 restaurant meals; and 10
- "(c) The cost of the program.". 12

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
