**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4029**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, after the first semicolon insert
2 “and” and after “338.095” insert a period and delete the rest of the line and
3 line 4.

4 Delete lines 6 through 26 and delete pages 2 and 3.

5 On page 4, delete lines 1 through 32 and insert:

6 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

7 **“(a) ‘Governing body’ means:**

8 **“(A) For a school district, the school district board.**

9 **“(B) For an education service district, the board of directors of the**
10 **education service district.**

11 **“(C) For a public charter school, the governing body of the public**
12 **charter school.**

13 **“(b) ‘Persons in leadership positions’ means:**

14 **“(A) For a school district, the directors of the school district and**
15 **the superintendent of the school district.**

16 **“(B) For an education service district, the directors of the education**
17 **service district and the superintendent of the education service dis-**
18 **trict.**

19 **“(C) For a public charter school, the members of the governing**
20 **body of the public charter school and the principal or executive di-**
21 **rector of the public charter school.**

1 “(c) ‘Public education provider’ means a school district, an educa-
2 tion service district or a public charter school.

3 “(2)(a) For each public education provider, the governing body shall
4 develop and, as needed, revise a professional learning plan.

5 “(b) A professional learning plan shall prescribe the training re-
6 quirements to be satisfied by persons in leadership positions of the
7 public education provider.

8 “(c) A professional learning plan must ensure that each person in
9 a leadership position of the public education provider receives training
10 on:

11 “(A) The roles and responsibilities of governing bodies, including
12 the requirements of public meetings and public records laws;

13 “(B) Mandatory reporting requirements for persons in leadership
14 positions;

15 “(C) School district budget and finance requirements and best
16 practices;

17 “(D) Understanding data on student progress;

18 “(E) School district improvement strategies; and

19 “(F) Any other areas of professional learning or training identified
20 by the governing body for the public education provider.

21 “SECTION 2. (1) No later than December 31, 2023, the governing
22 body of each public education provider shall conduct a self-assessment.
23 The self-assessment shall be used to develop a professional learning
24 plan described in section 1 of this 2022 Act. A self-assessment may be
25 conducted using a method developed by a statewide representative of
26 school district boards or a method selected by the governing body.

27 “(2) No later than June 30, 2024, each public education provider shall
28 adopt a policy that provides for:

29 “(a) The establishment of a professional learning plan; and

30 “(b) The procedure for determining when revisions to the profes-

1 **sional learning plan are necessary.”.**

2 In line 33, delete “6” and insert “3”.

3 In line 39, delete “7” and insert “4”.

4 On page 5, line 21, delete “8” and insert “5”.

5 On page 6, line 15, delete “9” and insert “6”.

6 In line 27, delete “10” and insert “7”.
