**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 1585**

1 Delete lines 4 through 12 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Consumer and Business Ser-**  
3 **vices, the Employment Department and the Oregon Health Authority**  
4 **shall enter into an intergovernmental agreement, as authorized under**  
5 **ORS 190.110, for the purpose of sharing information necessary to ena-**  
6 **ble the Department of Consumer and Business Services to inform**  
7 **beneficiaries of their rights under ORS 656.204.**

8 **(2) The information shared by the Oregon Health Authority under**  
9 **this section shall be the minimum necessary for the purpose set forth**  
10 **in subsection (1) of this section and is limited to information regarding**  
11 **deaths from COVID-19 associated with workplace outbreaks published**  
12 **by the authority.**

13 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2022 Act applies to data related to the**  
14 **rights of beneficiaries under ORS 656.204 arising before the date on**  
15 **which the state of emergency declared by the Governor on March 8,**  
16 **2020, for the COVID-19 pandemic, and any extension of the state of**  
17 **emergency, is no longer in effect.**

18 **“SECTION 3. Not later than December 15, 2022, the Department of**  
19 **Consumer and Business Services, in consultation with the Employ-**  
20 **ment Department and the Oregon Health Authority, shall submit a**  
21 **report, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, to the interim com-**

1 **mittees of the Legislative Assembly related to labor, that describes the**  
2 **implementation of section 1 of this 2022 Act.**

3 **“SECTION 4. This 2022 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
4 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
5 **declared to exist, and this 2022 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
