PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4043

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 22, delete "that is a seller of publicly supported housing".
- In line 25, after "section" delete the rest of the line and delete line 26 and insert "equals:
- 5 "(a) For housing owned by the taxpayer for at least five years, 2.5 percent
- of the lesser of the housing's sale price or the appraisal under section 4 (2)(e)
- 7 of this 2022 Act; or
- 8 "(b) For housing owned by the taxpayer for at least 10 years, five percent
- 9 of the lesser of the housing's sale price or the appraisal under section 4 (2)(e)
- 10 of this 2022 Act.".
- On page 2, delete lines 21 through 45.
- On page 3, delete lines 1 through 17 and insert:
- "SECTION 4. (1) Upon completion of a sale of publicly supported
- 14 housing, a seller intending to claim the credit allowed under section
- 15 3 of this 2022 Act shall apply to the Housing and Community Services
- 16 Department for certification.
- 17 "(2) The application for certification under this section must be on
- a form prescribed by the Housing and Community Services Depart-
- 19 ment and must provide:
- 20 "(a) The name, address and taxpayer identification number of the
- 21 seller and of the purchaser;

"(b) The location of the publicly supported housing;

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- "(c) A description of the use to which the housing will be put following the qualifying sale;
- "(d) The number of affordable housing units that will be maintained within the housing following the qualifying sale and the projected duration, in years, of the availability of the units as affordable housing;
- "(e) An appraisal of the housing conducted by an appraiser as defined in ORS 674.200;
- 9 "(f) The anticipated amount of credit to be claimed by the seller; 10 and
 - "(g) Any other information as the department may require.
 - "(3) The Housing and Community Services Department may review applications for certification using any reasonable system of prioritizing review established by the Housing and Community Services Department by rule.
 - "(4) Applications for certification filed in compliance with this section may be approved by the Housing and Community Services Department only to the extent that the total amount of credits for all approved qualifying sales for the calendar year is equal to or less than the limitation in section 6 of this 2022 Act. An application may not be approved, or a lesser amount of credit may be approved, if the addition of the anticipated amount of credit to previously approved amounts for the calendar year would exceed the limitation in section 6 of this 2022 Act.
 - "(5) Upon approval of an application for certification, and not later than January 15 of the year following the filing of the application, the Housing and Community Services Department shall issue a certification to the applicant. The certification must state the approved amount of credit. The certification may include conditions that must be met in order for a credit to be allowed to the seller under section

- 1 3 of this 2022 Act.
- "(6) At the end of each calendar year, the Housing and Community Services Department shall send a list of the names, addresses and taxpayer identification numbers of sellers to whom a certification has been issued under this section during the calendar year, along with approved amounts of credit for each qualifying sale, to the Department of Revenue.
 - "(7) A tax credit may not be issued under this section for the sale of a property that, within the previous 30 years, was awarded a tax credit under section 3 of this 2022 Act.
 - "(8) The Housing and Community Services Department may establish an application and precertification process for credits issued under this section.
 - "(9) Notwithstanding that a certification has been issued to a seller under this section, the Department of Revenue may disallow, in whole or in part, a claim for credit upon the department's determination that the seller is not entitled to the credit or is entitled only to a portion of the amount claimed under section 3 of this 2022 Act.
 - "(10) The Housing and Community Services Department may adopt rules to implement this section.".

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
