## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1514

- In line 2 of the printed bill, after "employment" insert "; creating new
- 2 provisions; amending ORS 652.210; and declaring an emergency".
- 3 Delete lines 4 through 8 and insert:
- 4 **"SECTION 1.** ORS 652.210 is amended to read:
- 5 "652.210. As used in ORS 652.210 to 652.235, unless the context requires
- 6 otherwise:
- 7 "(1)(a) 'Compensation' includes wages, salary, bonuses, benefits, fringe
- 8 benefits and equity-based compensation.
- 9 "(b) 'Compensation' does not include:
- 10 "(A) Vaccine incentives.
- "(B) A hiring bonus offered to a prospective employee.
- "(C) A retention bonus offered to an employee.
- "(2) 'Employee' means any individual who, otherwise than as a copartner
- of the employer, as an independent contractor or as a participant in a work
- training program administered under the state or federal assistance laws,
- 16 renders personal services wholly or partly in this state to an employer who
- pays or agrees to pay such individual at a fixed rate. However, when services

- 16 reau of Labor and Industries and to claims filed in a circuit court on
- or after March 1, 2022, and until the operative date specified in section
- 18 4 of this 2022 Act.

- "(2) The amendments to ORS 652.210 by section 2 of this 2022 Act
  - apply to complaints filed with the Commissioner of the Bureau of La-
- 21 bor and Industries and to claims filed in a circuit court on or after the
- operative date specified in section 4 of this 2022 Act.
- 23 "SECTION 4. The amendments to ORS 652.210 by section 2 of this
- 24 2022 Act become operative on the 180th day following the expiration
- or termination of the declaration of a state of emergency issued by the
- 26 Governor on March 8, 2020. For purposes of this section, the period in
- which the declaration of emergency is in effect includes any extensions
- 28 of the declaration of emergency.
- 29 "SECTION 5. This 2022 Act being necessary for the immediate
- 30 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is

declared to exist, and this 2022 Act takes effect on its passage.".
