## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4141

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete "creating new provisions; and 1 amending ORS 646.957" and insert "and prescribing an effective date". 2 Delete lines 4 through 28 and delete pages 2 through 4 and insert: 3 "SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Renewable Diesel is established. 4 "(2) The task force consists of 13 members appointed as follows: 5 "(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint two members from 6 among the members of the Senate, including one member from the 7 majority party and one member from the minority party. 8 "(b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint two 9 members from among the members of the House of Representatives, 10
- 13 "(c) The Governor shall appoint six members as follows:
  - "(A) One representative of truck owners with extensive experience using renewable diesel as a primary fuel source;

including one member from the majority party and one member from

- 16 "(B) One representative of an association representing the trucking 17 industry;
- 18 "(C) One representative of the renewable diesel industry;
- "(D) One representative of the petroleum diesel industry;
- 20 "(E) One representative of other businesses or industries that use 21 diesel fuel; and

- "(F) One representative of an environmental organization.
- "(d) The following shall serve as ex officio voting members of the task force:
- 4 "(A) The Director of Agriculture or the director's designee;
- 5 "(B) The Director of the Department of Environmental Quality or 6 the director's designee; and
- 7 "(C) The Director of the State Department of Energy or the 8 director's designee.
  - "(3) The task force shall:

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- "(a) Study the availability of renewable diesel in this state and incentives for increasing the availability of renewable diesel.
- 12 "(b) Develop estimates of current and future demand for diesel fuels 13 in this state, including separate estimates for:
- 14 "(A) The Portland metropolitan area;
- "(B) The portion of the state lying east of the Cascade Mountains; and
- 17 "(C) The portion of the state lying west of the Cascade Mountains.
- "(c) Develop recommendations for restrictions on the distribution of petroleum diesel designed to phase out the use of petroleum diesel in this state and increase the use of renewable diesel. Recommendations must include:
  - "(A) A proposed schedule for implementation of restrictions on the distribution of petroleum diesel in each region described in paragraph (b) of this subsection; and
- "(B) A threshold amount of renewable diesel availability, which
  may be expressed as a percentage of total diesel fuel demand in a region described in paragraph (b) of this subsection or in this state,
  above which restrictions on the distribution of petroleum diesel may
  commence and below which restrictions on the distribution of petroleum diesel must be paused or delayed.

- "(d) Analyze the cost difference between renewable diesel and other fuels, including petroleum diesel, using market data from Oil Price Information Service to calculate supply and demand implications if petroleum diesel is removed from the marketplace.
- 5 "(e) Develop recommendations for restrictions on the purchase and 6 use of petroleum diesel by state agencies.
- "(4) The task force may, upon the approval of a majority of the voting members of the task force, study or develop recommendations for matters related to the availability of renewable diesel in addition to those described in subsection (3) of this section.
- 11 "(5) A majority of the voting members of the task force constitutes 12 a quorum for the transaction of business.
  - "(6) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the voting members of the task force.
- 15 "(7) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as 16 chairperson.
  - "(8) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority shall make an appointment to become immediately effective.
- "(9) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson or of a majority of the voting members of the task force.
- 22 "(10) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation 23 of the task force.
- "(11) The task force shall submit a report, which may include recommendations for legislation, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245 to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the environment no later than December 31, 2022.
- 28 "(12) The State Department of Agriculture shall provide staff sup-29 port to the task force.
- 30 "(13) Members of the Legislative Assembly appointed to the task

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- force are nonvoting members of the task force and may act in an advisory capacity only.
- "(14) Members of the task force who are not members of the Legislative Assembly are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement for expenses and serve as volunteers on the task force.
  - "(15) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist the task force in the performance of the duties of the task force and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to confidentiality, to furnish information and advice the members of the task force consider necessary to perform their duties.
- "SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2022 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.
  - "SECTION 3. This 2022 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2022 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.".

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
